**Ikhaya Le Langa** (the house of Sun) is a 'not-for-profit' organization, functioning as an enterprise development 'hub' in Langa, the oldest historically Black township in the Western Cape.

Their lead project the '**Langa Quarter**' is the first of their Social Enterprise Precincts. The Langa Quarter now supports the 40 bed Langa Quarter Homestay Hotel. This social enterprise hotel is made up of 20 individual families, the majority entering into business for the first time.

**The Sun Diner** is our new 'social eatery'. Here we will provide training and development opportunities for FOH and BOH staff.
