Herewith some Water Wise Tips & Important contact details:

Some Basic Water Wise Tips:

Visible Signage in all public areas:

- FEDHASA Cape Water Wise Pledge is displayed at Reception desk for all guests to see
- Welcome letter amended to asks guests to please help us to ensure that the Western Cape dams do not run dry

Bathrooms & Rooms:

- Notices in all rooms informing guests that towels and linen will only be replaced every 3 days unless towels are dirty.
- Installed alcohol based hand sanitizers in all public bathrooms
- Bath plugs have been removed and a yellow plastic duckling with a water saving notice placed in all rooms
- Water saving heads
- Air rated taps
- Low flush Staff toilets (All toilet cisterns have been adjusted to 40% fill only)

Outside:

- Pool is currently closed until our underground reservoir pump will be switched on during peak season when the pool will re-open (NO municipal water to be used for your pool)
- All fountains on the property have been switched off until further notice.
- Gardens are being watered after connection of pump to irrigation
- Invested in storage tanks and booster pumps for emergency
- Turn mains water pressure down 50%
- Recycling washing machine waste water

Important things to remember:

- Start monitoring your water use (even if you only compare year-on-year your Municipal bills)
- You could also use the [AquaSmart Hotel tool](#) and start capturing what you are doing and measuring your progress
